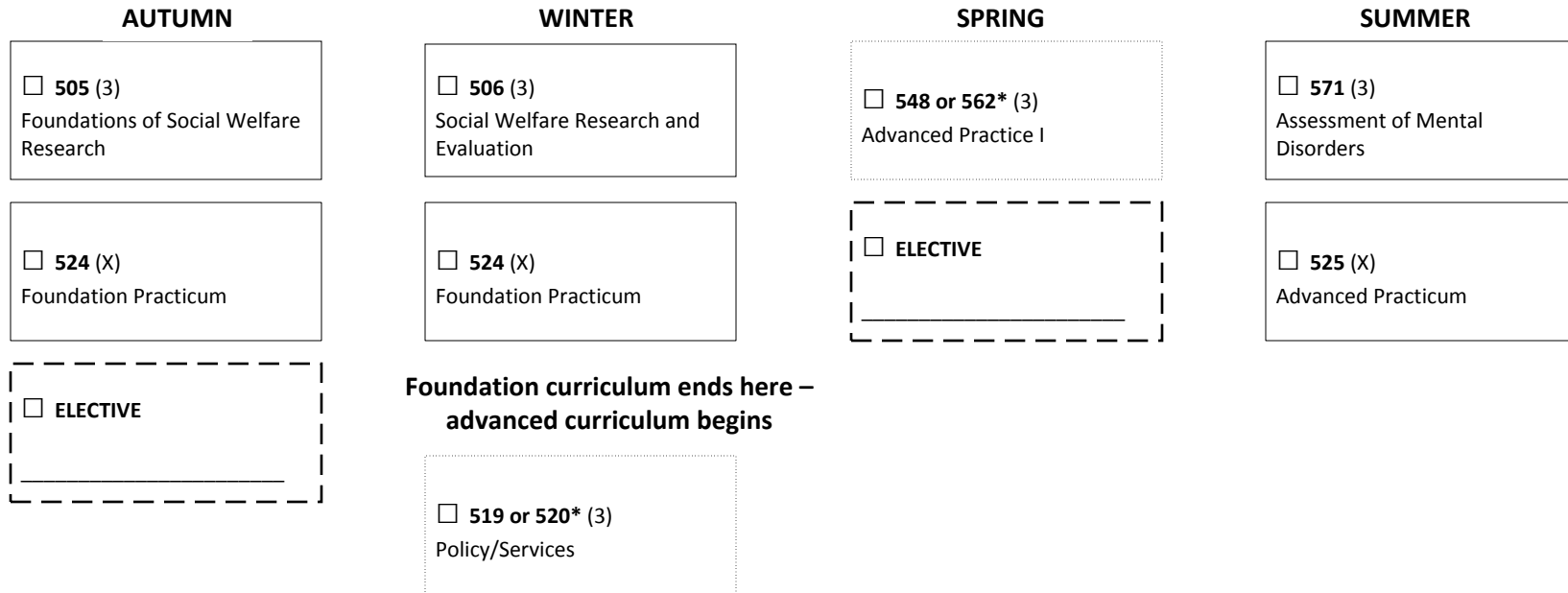

#### ALL STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

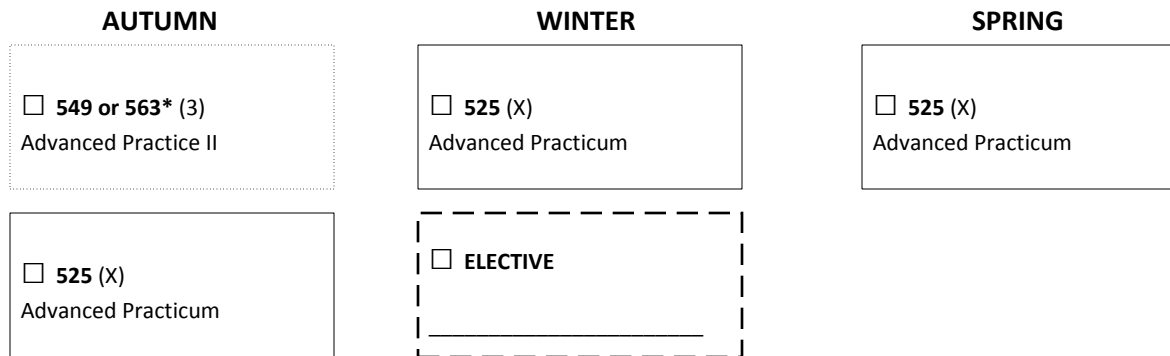
- 10 credits of foundation practicum (Soc W 524; 17 credits of advanced practicum (Soc W 525)
- 18 credits in numerically graded graduate classes
- Students may not elect to take any required courses through Autumn of their 2<sup>nd</sup> year as S/NS
- 18 credits in 500 level courses (no transfer credits count towards this requirement)
- 3.0 cumulative University of Washington GPA
- 2.7 required in all classes used for degree
- If thesis, minimum of 9 credits of 700 (which may count as electives)

**EDP students must complete a total of 75 credits, all with at least a 2.7 GPA**

### Notes:

- Practicum credits are shown as an X. Quarter-by-quarter plan and credit distribution may vary and are determined in conjunction with practicum faculty. Please note that CWTAP students follow a practicum schedule that may differ from the one listed above. For the foundation practicum, students are required to complete 400 hours or 10 credits. For the advanced practicum, students are required to complete 680 hours or 17 credits.

- A total of 9 elective credits are required. Electives may be taken any quarter. Electives shown for credit in the quarters above for illustration purposes. Students are limited to 3 credits of Soc W 599 or Soc W 600 for the elective requirement.
