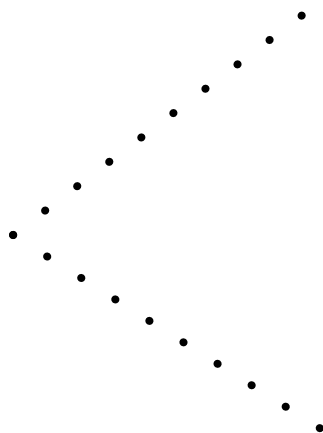

**ALL STUDENTS MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:**

- 18 credits of advanced practicum (Soc W 525)
- 18 credits in numerically graded graduate classes
- 18 credits in 500 level courses (no transfer credits count towards this requirement)
- 3.0 cumulative University of Washington GPA
- 2.7 required in all classes used for degree
- If thesis, minimum of 9 credits of 700 (which may count as electives)

**Notes:**

- HP and MHP students must take 2 electives (6 credits)
  - Recommended elective for HP – 557
  - Recommended electives for MHP – 570, 582, 584
- Students are limited to 3 credits of Soc W 599 or Soc W 600 for the elective requirement

**Advanced Standing students must complete a total of 48 credits, all with at least a 2.7 GPA**
